Students are a valuable part of the community and should be encouraged to value public participation in their neighborhoods and communities through volunteer service.

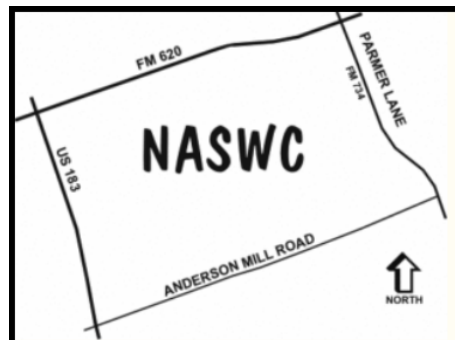

Doreen L. Scholtes (1953-2009) was a life member of the Texas PTA, produced newsletters for numerous community groups, served on the NASWC board, and was an election judge for Williamson County. In honor of her generous and diligent service, this scholarship award was founded in 2008.

QUALIFICATIONS AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants **MUST** reside in the household of a NASWC member (boundaries – Anderson Mill Road north to RM 620 (SH45) and Hwy 183 east to Parmer Lane) whose dues have been paid in full **before** submission of the application.



- One scholarship for **\$1,160.00** will be awarded to one high school senior who is graduating from a public, private, or home school during the academic year OR one student currently enrolled in a college, university, or accredited technical/trade school.
- Students **MUST** have a C average or better and **MUST** include a current transcript in an officially sealed envelope from the student’s school with this application.
- Students **MUST** submit two letters of recommendation from community leaders such as educators, religious leaders, elected officials, service organization leaders, or adult Scout leaders.
- NASWC will distribute the scholarship funds directly to the winner in the form of a check upon receipt of proof of registration for at least one semester at a college, university, trade, or technical school. Funds are to be used to help with college, university, technical, or trade school expenses.
